Subject: Upper Youghiogheny Hiker/Biker Trail

Secretary Kurtz,

As the conservation co-chairs for the Canoe & Kayak Cruisers Association of Metropolitan Washington DC and Montgomery County, MD residents, we are writing in favor of preserving the Upper Youghiogheny River as a wild and scenic river. The Canoe Cruisers Association(CCA) has many members in Montgomery, Frederick and other counties in Maryland who enjoy paddling the Upper Yough. The proposed hiker/biker trail will disturb the restored ecology of the Upper Yough. Proposed bridges will impede rafting and kayaking along the river, and a hardscape trail will increase impervious surface in an area that should remain forest.

The Upper Yough was designated a “Wild and Scenic River” in 1976. There was a desire to restore and preserve rivers from further environmental degradation. If the proposed hiker/biker trail goes forward, Maryland will be going in the opposite direction. Therefore we strongly urge your support in halting this project.
